

How to stack graphene up to four layers

Led by professor LEE Young Hee at the Center for Integrated Nanostructure Physics, IBS, the research team reports a novel method to grow multi-layered, single-crystalline graphene with a selected stacking order in a wafer scale. They obtained four-layered graphene using chemical vapor deposition (CVD) via Cu-Si alloy formation. Read more
