


# Korean Air freezes fuel surcharges on int'l routes

Korean Air Lines Co. is scheduled to freeze fuel surcharges on international routes in August despite high jet fuel prices, industry sources said Monday. Starting Aug. 1, South Korea's leading air carrier will apply a 42,900 won (US\$32.6) to 339,300 won surcharge on one-way tickets for international routes, depending on the route.
