


Plastic, paper cups-to-go will soon cost 300 won



Early human habitats linked to past climate shifts


A study published in Nature by an international team of scientists provides clear evidence for a link between astronomically-driven climate change and human evolution.

Unlocking the molecular mechanism of PTSD treatment

Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) is a difficult-to-cure mental health condition that is caused by experiencing a traumatizing event, such as interpersonal violence or disaster. While sufferers of PTSD have existed across all of human history and the condition is even observed in animals, the diagnosis of this condition only appeared in the 1970s after the Vietnam War.



Novel framework for classifying chaos and thermalization

One popular example of chaotic behavior is the butterfly effect - a butterfly may flap its wings in somewhere in the Atlantic Ocean and cause a tornado in Colorado. This remarkable fable illustrates how the extreme sensitivity of the dynamics of chaotic systems can yield dramatically different results despite slight differences in initial conditions.
