# Korea to scrap local age counting system from next year

Koreans are expected to get one or two years younger from June next year, as the country has decided to scrap the so-called "Korean age system" in favor of the internationally recognized age calculation standard.



#### IBS Researchers Ranked Among the 2022 List of Highly Cited Researchers

Eight researchers from the Institute for Basic Science (IBS) were included in this year's list of the world's most influential highly cited researchers (HCR). Clarivate Analytics is the world's leading information analytics company that provides analysis of bibliometric and scientometric data across 22 different research fields in academia. Clarivate designates the papers that have the top 1 percentile number of citations over the past 10 years as highly cited papers (HCP).



### Canonically Consistent Quantum Master Equation

A fundamental assumption, namely the Born approximation, in the theory of open quantum systems is overcome using statistical mechanics. In isolated quantum systems, correlated quantum states are essential for all emerging quantum technologies and have led to the 2022 noble prize in physics. However, in open quantum systems the correlations (quantum or classical) between the system of interest and the reservoir are typically ignored under the Born approximation.

## Synchronized neural oscillations in the right brain induce empathic behavior

A research team led by Dr. SHIN Hee-Sup at the Center for Cognition and Sociality (CCS) within the Institute for Basic Science (IBS) in Daejeon, South Korea has discovered the underlying neural mechanism that allows us to feel empathy. The group's study on mice hinted that empathy is induced by the synchronized neural oscillations in the right hemisphere of the brain, which allows the animals to perceive and share each other's fear.
